



# The Brockintons in Belize

## 2014 August Newsletter



**1. THE CIRCUS:** Three years ago a circus came to town. We met the kids and ministered to them. Well this same circus came to town in July and we ministered to the children daily. The circus children live a hard life: no school, constant travel and surrounded by adults who struggle with abuse and alcohol. We went to the circus compound daily to minister to the children. Brought the Spanish Bibles for all the adults and children, took them church twice and just daily loved on them. My children fell in love with these kids. We hated to see them leave. Please lift up these children in prayer. Two of them perform dangerous stunts in the circus and the others work concessions. (Genesis 13, Nyusky 11, Saied 10, Jose 11).



**2. ELIZABETH IS HERE:** Elizabeth is here and settling in. Right now we have teams, so life is a bit crazy, but she is already an awesome blessing to the ministry team here. By the end of August we should have two men (Eli and Tim) join the team and serve here in Belize.

**3. LIFE LEADERSHIP TRAINING (LLT):** We currently have 9 people going through our leadership development right now and 16 that have already completed the 23 week mentoring process. In August, we plan to start another LLT Net Group with about 7 attending. Our heart is discipleship. We also are beginning to develop our School of Ministry to raise up church planters and practically prepare them for the task.

**4. NET GROUPS:** We currently have 13 Nets and we are birthing a new one in August. We place a huge emphasis on our Nets for truly living out being the church.

**5. LEADERSHIP DINNER:** The team from Grace Covenant had a leadership dinner for nearly 80 leaders from four churches. It was a powerful evening of equipping.

**6. TEAMS:** We have had two teams back to back. Both were such a wonderful blessing to us. Ministering at Marla's Children's Home, VBS, Tutoring Center, door to door ministry, leading at church, water outreach, etc. Life has been soooo busy but what a blessing it has been.



**7. OUR BUDGET:** Our budget is healthy, but as Josh goes off to college & Kailey coming to live with us, there are some added expenses. Going from 3 kids to 4, especially paying for the travel cost of going to & from the states adds additional budgetary needs. The Lord & His people have always served Robyn & I so well during this journey in Belize & I have no doubt He

will provide all the additional needs in the season to come. There is also always more vision than we have funds for. So if you are **not** already partnering with us financially, please pray about starting & encouraging your local church to partner with us on a monthly basis.



**8. JOSHUA, OUR SON:** He is in the states and is doing great. He got a job at Office Depot and is enjoying it. He has connected to a local church and is loving it. In fact, the pastor's wife said that he has already impacted young people within the church and asked if he would serve as a small group leader. We are so proud of him. College begins in September.



A year ago, last August, we were at the Children's Home with a team. As the team was ministering, we were talking to the care taker. The care taker mentioned Kailey's name; and at that very moment, I felt the presence of God flow through my body. I welled up in tears and quickly composed myself. Unbeknownst to me, the very exact same thing happened to Robyn and Tori. We all knew in that very moment what God desired of us and for Kailey. Please pray for us as we navigate through the legal part of adoption, but also the emotional part. In our joy of gaining a daughter is the grief of losing her family. We know that God has set this up and chosen Kailey for our family and chosen us to walk this journey of healing with her, because He has given us those tools.
