



# The Brockintons in Belize

## 2014 April Newsletter



**1. REACHING YOUNG LEADERS:** LifeNet strategically planted in the capital to be close to the university to reach young people to Jesus and to raise them up as great leaders. We minister to about 290 people and average around 230 on a given Sunday. **74% of these people are younger than 30 years old.** Many of them are between the ages of 17-25. Raising up reproducible leaders is our heart and we are very excited that we are reaching so many young people for the Kingdom.

**2. COMING TO TEXAS IN MAY:** So here are some dates I have available to speak:

Sunday - May 11<sup>th</sup> - **OPEN** - Sunday morning and night available in the Katy area in two different churches

Sunday - May 18<sup>th</sup> - **FILLED** - Next Level in Katy, Texas.

Sunday - May 25<sup>th</sup> - **OPEN** - In the Dallas area (might have this filled). This would only be for the morning.

Sunday - June 1<sup>st</sup> - **FILLED** - Life Church in Katy, Texas

Available some Wednesday nights as well or throughout the week. I hope to meet with as many of you as I can while we are there.

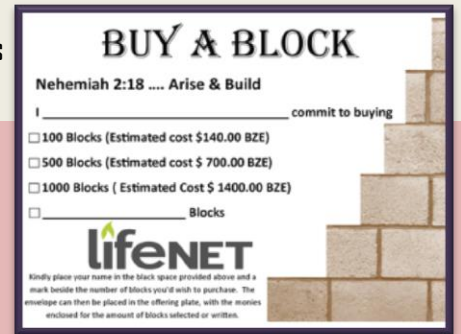
**3. OUR BUDGET:** Our budget is healthy, however the support process is a monthly journey. At times churches and or individuals need to stop supporting due to their own financial restraints and therefore we need others to begin support to off-set these losses. We soooo appreciate your faithfulness in partnering with us - we could not be here without you. If you are not already partnering with us financially, please pray about starting and encouraging your local church to begin partnering with us on a monthly basis. There is always more vision than we have funds for.



**4. BUILDING:** We need God's favor, supernatural provision and your help. There is such excitement in the people of LifeNet to build our own facility to be used as a tool to serve the Lord. Not only for us, but to use this building to serve the community through a **preschool** and utilizing the sanctuary as the largest venue in the city to **serve the government, university, as well as the community** at large. We also see the LifeNet facility utilized to equip leaders through a **School Of Ministry (SOM)**, which we are currently working on to raise up church planters to plant new churches. We feel we have created a usable facility that is adequate, but not luxurious or wasteful in any way. It will also hold a **parsonage** to offset the cost for future pastors. We have stepped out in **FAITH** to build sensing the Lord has said **YES**. The cost of this facility will be between **\$400,000-600,000U.S.** There is no loan process for churches here in Belize so this project will be built by us. This is a lot of money by U.S. standards & it is a crazy amount of money by Belizean standards.

**PLEASE JOIN ME IN PRAY FOR FINANCIAL PROVISION FOR THIS PROJECT.** We applied for a grant in hopes to begin the building with, but we were declined. Our prayer is for **\$100,000 US** this year to get the project well on its way. This would allow us to lay the foundation, slab, columns and roof. YES – Please agree with us in **PRAYER** for **supernatural favor, divine contacts,** & an **abundance of generosity** will be poured out on LifeNet to see this come to pass in a timely manner. We serve a **BIG GOD** who has **BIG PLANS** for this church.

**5. BUY A BLOCK:** We just began a BUY A BLOCK campaign for LifeNet. We are asking the members of LifeNet to pray about how many blocks they will buy for the project. The blocks are for the first floor. The second story walls are metal. Our people here truly desire ownership of this journey. It excites me to see their excitement for what God is doing. Between the blocks and the steel for the slab – we need about **\$15,000 US.**



**6. ANNIVERSARY:** March 9<sup>th</sup> we celebrated LifeNet's 3<sup>rd</sup> anniversary. What an amazing day it was. The presence of God was so powerful and the people came to celebrate Jesus and celebrate what He has done over the last three years at LifeNet.

**7. FOURSQUARE CABINET:**

The Lord allowed me the privilege to serve on the Foursquare Cabinet for another year. What a blessing to connect to pastors, District



Supervisors from across the U.S., and fellow missionaries, to work together to see God do awesome things with and through our Foursquare family. In the room were great men of God like **Jack Hayford** and **Wayne Cadero**. I watched as the Holy Spirit directed us to recommend the implementation of steps to see our movement flourish in our mission for years to come.

**8. JOSHUA TURNS 18:** Yes, it's true. Our oldest son turned 18 on the 28<sup>th</sup> of March. In one month, we head to Texas and leave him in Dallas for college. He will need to get a job, buy a car and get settled in before college starts in August. We are going to miss him so much, but we are very excited for him and his future. God has given us 18 years to pour godly values into this young man and now it is time for him to thrive. We are so confident that he is ready and well prepared to serve the Lord on his own. Pray for him as he settles into a new church, finds a job, good friends and a car.
