OUR BUDGET: With some aspects of the economy struggling, some of our partners needed to suspend their financial support for a season. This loss of support put a **BIG** dent in our budget and we need to raise about \$1700 a month. BUILDING PROGRESS: We are currently installing the second set of strip footings for the foundation. There are two more sections to install and then we are ready for the foundation. There are teams coming in March and April that plan to have a role in the construction process.
