## 2014 July Newsletter

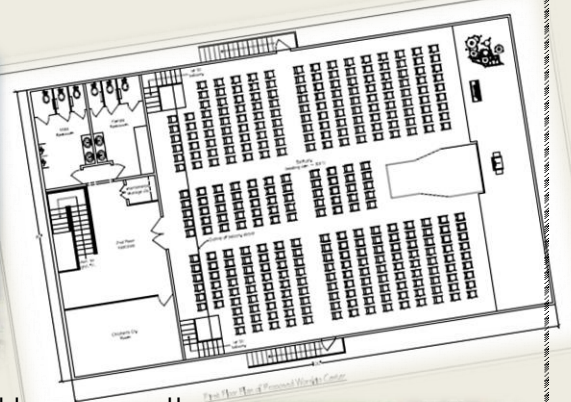


**It's been over a month since I last sent a newsletter & I have so much to share with ya.**

- 1. IN THE STATES:** In the month of May my family came to Texas to spend time with family, friends, churches and the Foursquare Convention in Dallas.
- a. We visited and ministered in 6 churches in 4 weeks.
  - b. We had a wonderful time and were refreshed and poured into.
  - c. Heard Francis Chan twice – one of my favorite ministers.
  - d. Josh was blessed with a car for college – praise the Lord...
  - e. Wonderful times with family and friends.
  - f. Had some personal time with my son before he goes off to college.



**2. BUILDING:** Please intercede for the building process. Hopefully we should have city approval on the plans this month. The fundraising process has been **much slower** than I anticipated. I am still believing for \$100,000 in 2014 to lay the foundation and put on the roof. LifeNet, is currently raising funds for the walls and steel.



**3. MISSIONARIES AND INTERNS:** Starting July 7<sup>th</sup>, LifeNet will have another missionary to serve here. Elizabeth is coming to primarily raise up and equip Belizean children ministers, but she will be involved in many areas of the church. Elizabeth came from our home church where I used to pastor and we have seen her saved, disciplined, go off to Bible school and now joining us on the field. If this is not exciting enough, **two missionary interns** will be joining us in August. These two guys will help develop a **School Of Ministry** for raising up church planters and helping us to plant a new church in a village. They would serve LifeNet for one year and potentially two years and then we would be privileged to send them to another nation to plant a church and establish a work in that nation. This is a wonderful opportunity for the Belizean church to have a role in global missions. Please join us in prayer for these three – it



could be a powerful boost for LifeNet and the outreach we are doing here.

**4. TEAMS:** I have three teams coming over the next six weeks. One from North Carolina, California and one from Texas. These will be very diversified groups. Some of the groups will focus on the ministries from LifeNet, one will host a leadership dinner for our four churches within Foursquare here and the other one we are working to partner with us to conduct a ministry trip to Caye Caulker, an island off the coast of Belize. The team going to the island would partner with us as LifeNet to take our first mission trip from our church to bless another village.

**5. Kailey:** I have spoken in the past about a young lady named Kailey (13) that we have in our home on the weekends. Well, if things go as planned, we should have her move into our home permanently within the month of July. We are very excited, but do not want to get our hopes up too high. The system has a way of moving very slow and taking quick turns. We have been working on this process for over a year now. When it all happens, we will tell you more and tell you how the Lord led us to bring this girl into our home – it was truly a supernatural moment. If all goes well, we will bring her back with us to the states next summer and introduce her to you. Please pray for us on this exciting journey...



**5. OUR BUDGET:** Our budget is healthy, but as Josh goes off to college & Kailey coming to live with us, there are some added expenses. Going from 3 kids to 4, especially paying for the travel cost of going to & from the states adds additional budgetary needs. The Lord & His people have always served Robyn & I so well during this journey in Belize & I have no doubt He will provide all the additional needs in the season to come. There is also always more vision than we have funds for. **So if you are not already partnering with us financially, please pray about starting & encouraging your local church to partner with us on a monthly basis.**

**6. NET GROUPS:** Our newest Net is already running 15 on a weekly basis and we should birth one more and perhaps two more Nets within the next six weeks. We truly want to develop leaders and release people to touch their city for Jesus.

**7. LifeNet SUNDAYS:** Pray for us. May is historically our lowest Sunday attendances of the year. Our attendance literally falls off about 35% and then we regain around August. This year is no different. Pray that this summer will be a season of reaching, growing, discipling and equipping.

**8. YOUNG ADULTS:** Pray for our young adults. They are pulled so hard by the world. Over the last six months, we have had a couple fall away. Some went and got jobs that compete with their ability to attend Sundays and Nets and others are just affected by the pull of the world.

**9. JOSH AND COLLEGE:** Please keep Josh in your prayers as he gets adjusted into dorm life, a job and college in general. We were blessed with some scholarships, but he will need to take out Federal Loans of about \$5600 a year for the next four years. Please pray that the Lord will provide so that he does not have to graduate with debt.
