FIVE YEARS AS LIFENET. In March, we celebrated LifeNet's 5th anniversary. 225 people came out to celebrate. We have seen over 300 make professions of faith, over 100 baptisms, and over 150 going through our discipleship process. To God be all the glory. Thank you for partnering with us. Your prayers and your financial support allows us to be the hands and feet of Jesus here in Belize.



OUR BUDGET: First of all, **THANK YOU** to all that sow into the work here in Belize. We could not do it without you. Your financial sacrifice allows us to be here. Last month I shared that we were about 15% under budget for the year. I can rejoice with you that there are families that saw the need and chose to begin support or increased their support. We still need to raise about \$1300 more per month to meet our needs. TORI'S TURKEY TRIP: By the time this newsletter is sent out, Tori (our 17 year old) will be in Turkey working with a missionary family and serving over 150 Syrian Refugees. Please pray for peace and safety. Istanbul, Turkey, is not the most stable area in the world today. An ISIS suicide bomber just blew himself up in Istanbul last week, killing several innocent people. This is the direction the Lord has led Tori in and we are confident that He will take care of her.



CITY-WIDE EASTER EGG HUNT: I had the privilege to pray over 700 kids at the City's Easter Egg Hunt. Elizabeth & one of our church teens was able to share the gospel through puppets.



TEAMS: In March, we had a high school senior class from Living Stones Church come and work on the property, minister in Maya Mopan, Heart House and much more. In April, a team from the Sanctuary Church in Southern California coming to pour our 2nd section of slab.



BUILDING UPDATE: We are praying and believing for the entire slab to be poured before the beginning of May.



SERVING THOSE IN NEED: Last week, I was back in Maya Mopan with

our Ketchi Net (small group) and heard that one of our members did not have any beds to sleep on and they were sleeping on the concrete floor. If that wasn't bad enough, last week they killed a Tommy Goff inside their house. A Tommy Goff is the most poisonous snake in Belize. I published the need on Facebook and within hours, people were contacting me to see how they could help. From pastors in the US to Believers here in Belize. We bought some hammocks for them temporarily and people are donating beds. I love how the Body of Christ comes together and serves.



NEEDS: Many times people ask for smaller things that the ministry needs. One of those needs is a LCD projector. We have one, but use a second one as a backup and for children's ministry. An Epson projector is preferred, but here are other links to less expensive ones as well.
