2014 March Newsletter



GOD IS SO GOOD!! What an amazing month this has been. I HAVE SO MUCH TO SHARE WITH YOU.

1. THE BUILDING: Pictured above is an artistic rendering of our future building. The people of LifeNet Church are so excited about our future home. I think I shared last month the interior (see February's newsletter). The building will house a parsonage, preschool and classes and offices. Upstairs will be the sanctuary, which will hold 350 and a phase 2 future balcony that will hold an additional 125 people. Here are the prayer needs for the building:

- a. The building will cost a minimum of **\$400,000 US**. We had hoped it would cost less than \$250,000. We're believing this will be a partnership between LifeNet Church here, churches and individuals in the states.
- b. There is no such thing here as a church loan. Therefore, we will build this over two years as we have the funds.
- c. We are hoping that teams will come with funds and labor to build a section of the facility at a time.
- d. Our hope is that this year, we will lay the foundation and erect the roof. This will cost a little over \$100,000.
- f. Pray with me that churches and individuals in the states will be led to partner with us to build this tool for the Kingdom. This is a HUGE faith walk for us. It is way beyond our ability in the natural.

2. GROUND BREAKING SERVICE: February 9th (see pics) It was a logistic nightmare to hold a service with no water, electricity, toilets or any other accommodations for the service. We planned for a month for this huge event only to have it rain and rain and rain all night before and during the service. There was mud everywhere. All that to say ----- no one complained. Everyone came with an anticipation and excitement of our future. **It was a POWERFUL, EXCITING & GOD FILLED DAY.**

3. BACK TO CHURCH SUNDAY: February 16th. This was an outreach Sunday. We had 10 salvations. **2014 has started off so exciting.**

4. LIFE ADVANCE: We conducted our 4th Life Advance on February 22nd. This is our 2nd step in our discipleship process. We had 25 come - which is the maximum we will take. 19 of the 25 were under 30 years old. The presence of the Holy Spirit was sooo thick. People were filled, healed, delivered and set free. God did so much in their lives.

5. MISSION TEAM FROM KANSAS: We had a huge team of 30 come to build a house in Maya Mopan and began some work on the church property. They ministered in the schools, Marla's Children's Home, Heart House Tutoring Center, VBS in Maya Mopan and lots of evangelism. They also ministered to our children during children's church, joined in with our praise team and ministered the Word. (See pics below)

6. SUNDAY CELEBRATION: February 23rd - The team from Kansas ministered during our Sunday Celebration.

Before anyone arrived, our leaders felt that God was going to move in a POWERFUL way. Worship began -- there was literally not a seat in the room - it was standing room only with over 280 people there. We ended worship with the song: *Break Every Chain*. The presence of God was so powerful that we had an altar call right then and about 20 came forward for personal ministry -- lots of tears. Then Pastor Loren (pastor of Emmanuel 4SQ in Kansas) ministered the word. He preached an awesome message and ended by challenging people to accept the Lord - 12 people stood to their feet to accept the Lord. WOW !! God is amazing. I am sooooo excited about what God is doing through the people of LifeNet.

- a. For the constructions process and the funding. We have applied for a grant. Pray we are accepted. The grant would get us started.

- b. Pray for us and Joshua. When we go to the states in May, we will leave him there to get a job, buy a car and prepare to go to college.
 - Please join us for favor with scholarships and or grants.
 - Please pray for favor for the right car to buy at the right price.
- c. For those that have read my newsletter about the difficulties in December, that situation continues to poke its head out. Pray for complete victory in this situation. Dealing with this incident last December was the hardest issue that I have ever dealt within Ministry.
- d. Pray for our leaders. Over the next 2 months, we should birth several new Net Groups. Birthing new Nets is all about raising up reproducible disciples and leaders.
