1. BAPTISMS: In April, we baptized 10 people and saw over 12 come to Christ. We did the baptism at a local creek. We normally do not do the baptisms at a creek or river because the areas tend to be more dangerous, especially for cars getting broken into. But we found this spot close by and it was PERFECT. It felt more like where Jesus would have baptized. Kids were playing in the background; some of the townspeople were there relaxing. Definitely, not all of them were Believers, but this is the way I see it happened in the New Testament. It was the river after all, where people gather. Where they washed clothes, wash themselves and just cooled off. All this to say: I loved it and we will definitely do another baptism there.




2. TEAMS: We had two teams here in April. One was a mixed-martial art ministry that went to over 5 schools and our Thursday night Net group in Belmopan & then had a rally on Friday night. The rally had about 200 in attendance. The second team was from, Life Church, our sending church. They went & spent a week back in Maya Mopan living on cots & hammocks & living in the homes of some of our families from the church here. They simply lived life with them; went fishing & cutting down trees in the forest & yes, used the outdoor showers & outhouses!! They went door to door evangelizing & just loving people like Jesus did. At night they conducted a Life Advance (this is part of our discipleship process), about 15 Ketchi speaking people attended.

OUR BUDGET: Our budget is healthy, however the support process is a monthly journey. **If you are not already partnering with us financially, please pray about starting & encouraging your local church to begin partnering with us on a monthly basis.** There is always more vision than we have funds for.

7. NET GROUPS: We have birthed two new Net Groups @ LifeNet. One in Cayo, a community about 30 minutes away and a youth NET back in Maya Mopan. This will make 3 Nets back in Maya Mopan. We currently have 14 Nets with a 2014 goal of 17. Our true heart is the raise up leaders. Leaders that will raise up leaders. Nets are the vehicle to raise up and release great leaders to reach, disciple and raise up other leaders. Quote from the book: How To Multiply Your Church by Ralph Moore. **"The call to discipleship is a call to mission. Personal piety is part of the package. It was not, and is not, the end goal. Discipling the nation is"**. Our goal to raise up leaders is a goal to touch a nation.

8. EASTER: Easter was awesome!! We had 258 in attendance which is great, because Easter in Belize is not always the largest event for churches. The city literally shuts down and many people leave on vacation. We had one salvation and the presence of God was strong. It was a wonderful time.



9. JOSHUA: Prayers as we head to Texas and buy a car for Josh, settle him into a job, college and a million other things for him. Financial provision for college as well.



10. MINISTRY NEEDS: Our church projector is going out. A new one should cost under \$400. We also need to buy a sub-woofer for \$800.
