1. HOPE TO SEE YA IN MAY: My schedule is pretty booked, but I still have one Wednesday night to fulfill and could make room for a couple of more Mission Parties. A Mission Party is when an individual hosts a group of 15-20 adults. The Brockinton family would come to share our vision and what God is doing in Belize. This is primarily for families that attend churches that I have not ministered at or that it has been a long time since I have ministered there. 2. CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS: Nothing more has been done since last month, but **the next step will be to roof it for \$10,000US.** We currently have about \$4000US raised. After that the next phase is the strip footings and the slab that will cost roughly \$26,000US. After that, the walls, then to begin on the inside. Please join us in prayer for the needed funds for the facility.

3. PRAISES: In April, we **baptized 3 more people.** We have also experienced powerful moves of God during our Sunday services. There also seems to be a renewed passion for discipleship among our people.

4. SUMMER SLUMP: From January to April we have experienced a growth of 9% in our Sunday services, but if our past history dictates our present, when May comes, our attendance declines by about 35%. June is better, July is better and by September, we are consistently back over 200. Some of this has to do with lots of holidays in May, but some of this has to do with me being in Texas. **This is a real point of prayer because the desire is for LifeNet to thrive beyond my tenure as pastor.** The church must become sustainable by Belizean leadership after I am gone. **May is almost a thermometer to determine how well we are doing.** Please join me in prayer that May services will thrive in my absence. **There are some great signs.** There is a growing interest in the development of our youth that is being developed beyond my presence. **I am seeing young married leaders step up into ministry like never before.** These are great signs.
