**1. PASTOR'S /LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE:** I spoke for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year at the Pastor's/Leadership Conference. I taught a workshop on the implementation of a small group ministry.

**2. CROSS OUTREACH:** We had two guys (Aric & David) come into town and serve alongside LifeNet. They simply carried the cross all over Belmopan and people would gather to hear why they were here. It was very non-confrontational, literally the cross just gathered people and then we got a chance to share of the greatest gift of all: JESUS.



**3. FRIEND DAY:** This is always our largest service of the year. Our members reached out to their unchurched friends and relatives and we had 290 people at celebration, with 13 salvations, and 26 visitors filled out a visitor card. It was a powerful Sunday.



**4. ROBYN SHARING AT WOMEN'S CONFERENCE:** Robyn is the type of person that would prefer to be behind the scenes rather than be in front of people, but after 20 years of ministry – she has lots of wisdom to share. ## 5. DISCIPLSHIP AND LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT IS OUR HEART:

This month we prayed over our 3 newest Net Group Leaders. We have new leadership in our University Net and multiplied another Net. I see this new Net potentially multiplying next year. Our Thursday Net just started taking 4 people through the Life Manual which is the beginning process for discipleship and another 7 through our Life Leadership Training which is our leadership track.

**6. ROBYN'S PARENTS COMING:** Robyn's parents are coming this month. Robyn's mom, Bev, will have a Saturday ministry time with the ladies.

**7. NATIONAL LEADERSHIP TRANSITION:** We have 4 churches that make up our small network of churches in Belize. The current National Leader is a Panamanian missionary and we will be choosing a Belizean leader in April of 2015. Please be praying for us as we navigate through this process. The heart of missions is to raise up indigenous leaders to assume the leadership roles within a country so that the work is sustainable beyond the work of a missionary. This is a very important transition for our churches.

**8. TIM AND ELI:** Our new interns have arrived and are already getting really plugged in. Our job is to really immerse them into all the areas of ministry within the church. They will serve LifeNet for 2 years.

**9. NET SUNDAY:** Net Sunday was a day we focused on the importance of small group life among our people. It was a very successful day of casting our vision to our members.

## 10. PLEASE PRAY FOR UPCOMING OUTREACH AND LEADERSHIP EVENTS:

**November 16<sup>th</sup> – Community of Cultures:** This is a Sunday that we celebrate the 15-17 different cultures that make up the LifeNet family.

**November 23<sup>rd</sup> – DAY OF GRATITUDE:** An outreach Sunday where we focus on being thankful.

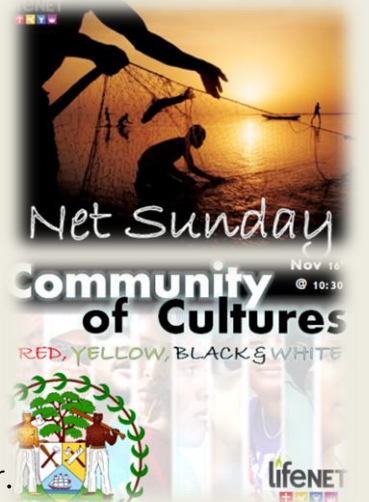
**December 21<sup>st</sup> – NET NOEL:** A Day our Net Groups bless the church with dramas, worship, & skits. Last year was such an awesome time together.

**11. OUR BUDGET:** Some have already responded and thank you so much. 2015 budget will need to grow some. Inflation and our ministry needs are affecting our budget. Our rent, Josh in college and bringing another child into our home affects the bottom line. We have relied on basically the same budget for the last four years and we will need to tweak it to accommodate our needs here in Belize. So if you are **not** already partnering with us financially, please pray about starting & encouraging your local church to partner with us on a monthly basis.

**12. BUILDING PROCESS:** PLEASE CONTINUE TO PRAY. After 10 months, we are still attempting to get city approval to move forward. On a PRAISE note, we have had a couple of churches and individuals communicate with us about sowing into the process and perhaps bringing teams to help build, which will be a HUGE blessing.
