4. I had the privilege of traveling to **Belize City** to share a **devotional** with about 30 employees of Scotia Bank. What a blessing to be invited to a place of business to share Biblical principles to the staff. I was the first person, outside the bank, to come and share. Belize is such a "religious nation" and many are disillusioned by "religion". Pray that I will communicate a realness of who Jesus is and how the church can be relevant to this generation.

5. **Parade Outreach.** LifeNet participated for the 3rd time in the capital's Independence parade. Independence Day was on Sunday this year, so we decided to **BE THE CHURCH**, rather than **ATTEND** the church. We created a float, jammed to some relevant Christian music and passed out over **6500 waters** and flyers to the watchers of the parade. What a powerful opportunity to go where the lost are and to love like Jesus. One Believer watching the parade said this about the outreach, **"One of the things that I thought was very impressive as we were standing watching all the different floats go by, Pastor Lee from LifeNet church came by and handed me a water. Their group that was passing out water was a friendly group. What a great way of showing the love of Christ. The one thing that came to my mind right away was the words that Jesus spoke. The one that wants to be greatest must become the servant of all"**.

I would estimate that over **15,000** people attended the parade.

6. PLEASE PRAY FOR UPCOMING OUTREACH AND LEADERSHIP EVENTS:

October 2nd-4th – Our Worship Leader will host a **Pastor/Leadership Conference**. It will be the 4th time that I have ministered at this conference. This year I will conduct a Round Table Discussion on **small group ministry**. About 50-60 pastors come and this year it will be in Belmopan.

October 5th – **Friend Day**. A day where everyone invites an unchurch friend. We are expecting 300 people. Pray for many to come to salvation. I am very excited about my message. Here is a commercial we made for Friend Day – it's funny:

October 25th – Our **Life Advance**, which is a weekend retreat that is a second tier of our discipleship process. We normally have about 20 students.

October 26th – **NET SUNDAY**: Net Sunday is a day we focus on our small groups called Nets in our Sunday celebration service.

November 16th – **Community of Cultures**: This is a Sunday that we celebrate the 15-17 different cultures that make up the LifeNet family.

November 23rd – **DAY OF GRATITUDE**: An outreach Sunday where we focus on being thankful.

December 21st – **NET NOEL**: A Day our Net Groups bless the church with dramas, worship, and skits. Last year was such an awesome time together.

NEXT YEAR: We plan on starting a **School of Ministry (SOM)** to raise up church planters and plant our first church from out from among us in a village about thirty minutes away.

7. OUR BUDGET: 2015 budget will need to grow some. Inflation and our ministry needs are affecting our budget. Our rent on our house has gone up. Josh being in college is affecting our needs and bringing another child into our home affects the bottom line. As part of our family, we will bring her to the U.S. when we come in the summer and this will obviously affect our budget. We have relied on basically the same budget for the last four years and we will need to tweak it to accommodate our needs here in Belize. **So if you are not already partnering with us financially, please pray about starting & encouraging your local church to partner with us on a monthly basis.**

4. BUILDING PROCESS: After eight months of waiting, we think that our building plans are about to be approved by the city. If so, we can begin on the foundation of the building. We have had a couple of churches and individuals communicate with us about sowing into the process and perhaps bringing teams to help build – which will be a HUGE blessing. We are

believing for \$100,000 this year. This amount will lay the slab, erect the beams and the roof for the building. Once that is done, we will be ready for the brick walls to go up. We are praying and believing that we can at least move onto the property by the end of 2015. The building will not be complete, but hopefully enough to hold services there. Another BIG issue of prayer is for favor with the city on the road onto our property.
